for installations in residential or business environments. The system is ideal for monitoring the interiors and exteriors of a property and can be scaled up as needs change. Home and business owners can enjoy full control of their Uniden Guardian Hybrid DVR security system with a host of premium features and enhanced configuration flexibility.

Choose a combination of wired internet IP cameras, which rely on an Ethernet cable for internet connectivity, as well as wireless IP cameras. These cameras connect to the internet wirelessly via an app and are useful for locations where a video cable cannot be reached, such as a garage or patio.

Remote access provides the ability to watch and record live via a dedicated iOS/Android app on a smartphone or tablet device. The app also sends push notifications and email alerts whenever the system detects movement.

Full HD 1080p resolution is ideal for zooming in to view minute details - such as licence plates and facial features - which become critical in the event of an incident. In addition, night vision provides up to 20 metres of exceptionally clear picture quality, allowing users to capture significant details from dusk to dawn.

Other key features include around-the-clock digital video surveillance, USB back-up and internal storage of one and two terabyte storage capacities. An HDMI port allows viewing of footage on big screen televisions, making it practical for homeowners who want to zoom in on an image for closer examination.

All wired and wireless cameras from the Uniden Guardian range are weatherproof to withstand the harsh Australian elements. The Guardian Hybrid DVR can be expanded with all other existing Uniden Guardian wireless cameras including the pan, tilt and zoom App Cam 36, weatherproof outdoor App Cam 35 and the App Cam 34 dome for mounting from ceilings.

The Guardian Hybrid DVR can be set-up as DIY or installed by an electrician for users who lack the confidence in setting up a security system independently.
